ERASMUS+ INFORMATION 2024-25

Dear student,

You can find below information about the application procedures for 2024/25 Erasmus incoming students at the University of Salamanca.

*Please note that we will not answer any message requesting information already provided or available on our website. In any case, this office will only see **specific administrative questions** that cannot be solved through any of the links offered here. **Academic questions** must be addressed to the **International Academic Coordinator at the corresponding faculty, school or university centre.***

1st STEP: ERASMUS REGISTRATION

Registration deadline	July 1st, 2024 for ALL STUDENTS (WINTER SEMESTER, SUMMER SEMESTER or FULL ACADEMIC YEAR). There is no second deadline for 2 nd -semester applications.
Application Form	<p>The online Erasmus Application Form is available on our website:</p> <p>https://rel-int.usal.es/en/students/incoming-students/erasmus-student-mobility-for-studies</p> <p>-> "Erasmus Incoming Students Online Application 2024-25"</p> <p>Students duly nominated by their home institution must complete the online Erasmus Application Form, print it as a pdf and send it by email to the International Office-Inbound Mobility (erasmus-in@usal.es), together with:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • a recent passport-size photograph • a copy of the ID document or passport <p>This document is a MANDATORY REQUIREMENT for the correct enrolment of Erasmus students at the University of Salamanca. Incomplete forms or lacking a photograph won't be considered.</p>

2nd STEP: OTHER DOCUMENTS

Acceptance Letter	As of June 19th, 2024 , an Acceptance Letter will be sent by email (with a copy to the Erasmus responsible at their institution) to those students who have correctly sent the Application Form and the other required documents. Students must bring this Acceptance Letter to Salamanca and present it when enrolling in the corresponding Centre.
Learning Agreement	<p>The University of Salamanca is connected with the EWP network and accepts Online Learning Agreements. The OLA must be sent for approval and signature to the corresponding International Departmental Coordinator in Salamanca. Please, do not send OLAs / Learning Agreements' requests to the International Office; they will be automatically disregarded.</p> <p>(See below <i>Academic Information - Erasmus Academic Coordinators</i>)</p>

Compulsory Mobility and Health Insurances

- **Mobility Insurance:** The Mobility Insurance of the University of Salamanca is **mandatory** for all Erasmus students regardless of the requirements and/or regulations of the student's home institution on the matter. This insurance must be purchased by each student directly via the website. Instructions will be sent with the Acceptance Letter.
- **Health Care:** Students from the EU, EFTA and Switzerland are entitled to medical care in the medical centres and hospitals that form part of or have agreements with the Spanish National Health System (*Seguridad Social*). Students must apply for the **European Health Card (EHC)** at the health service offices in their country of origin (**GHIC** for UK students or **A/T11** for Turkish students). Foreign students from other countries than the above-mentioned or who are not covered by national health plans must have **private health insurance**.

Students must send, **before arriving in Salamanca**, a copy of **both documents by e-mail** to the International Relations Office (erasmus-in@usal.es) as a **mandatory requirement to complete their inscription** at the University of Salamanca.

Language of instruction

The language of instruction at our institution is **SPANISH**. Students must have sufficient Spanish skills before coming in order to be able to follow lectures.

Minimum recommended level: **B1** (no certificate required).

Spanish Language Courses

The University of Salamanca offers, at the beginning of each semester (September, October and November for the 1st semester, and February/March for the 2nd semester), a **Spanish intensive course** to all Erasmus students who wish to take it. Students must pay fees for course materials and linguistic consulting.
