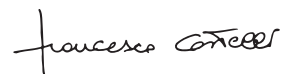

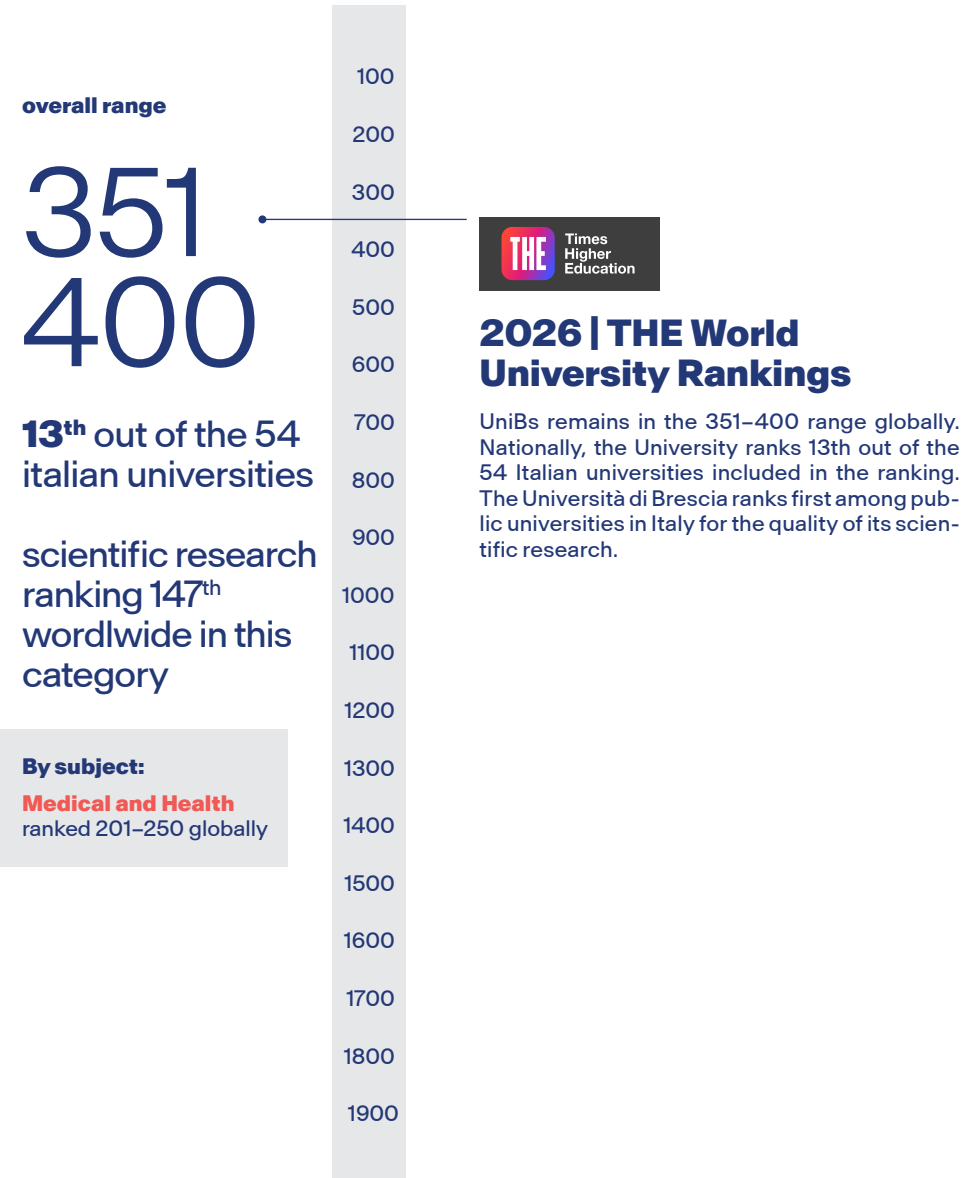

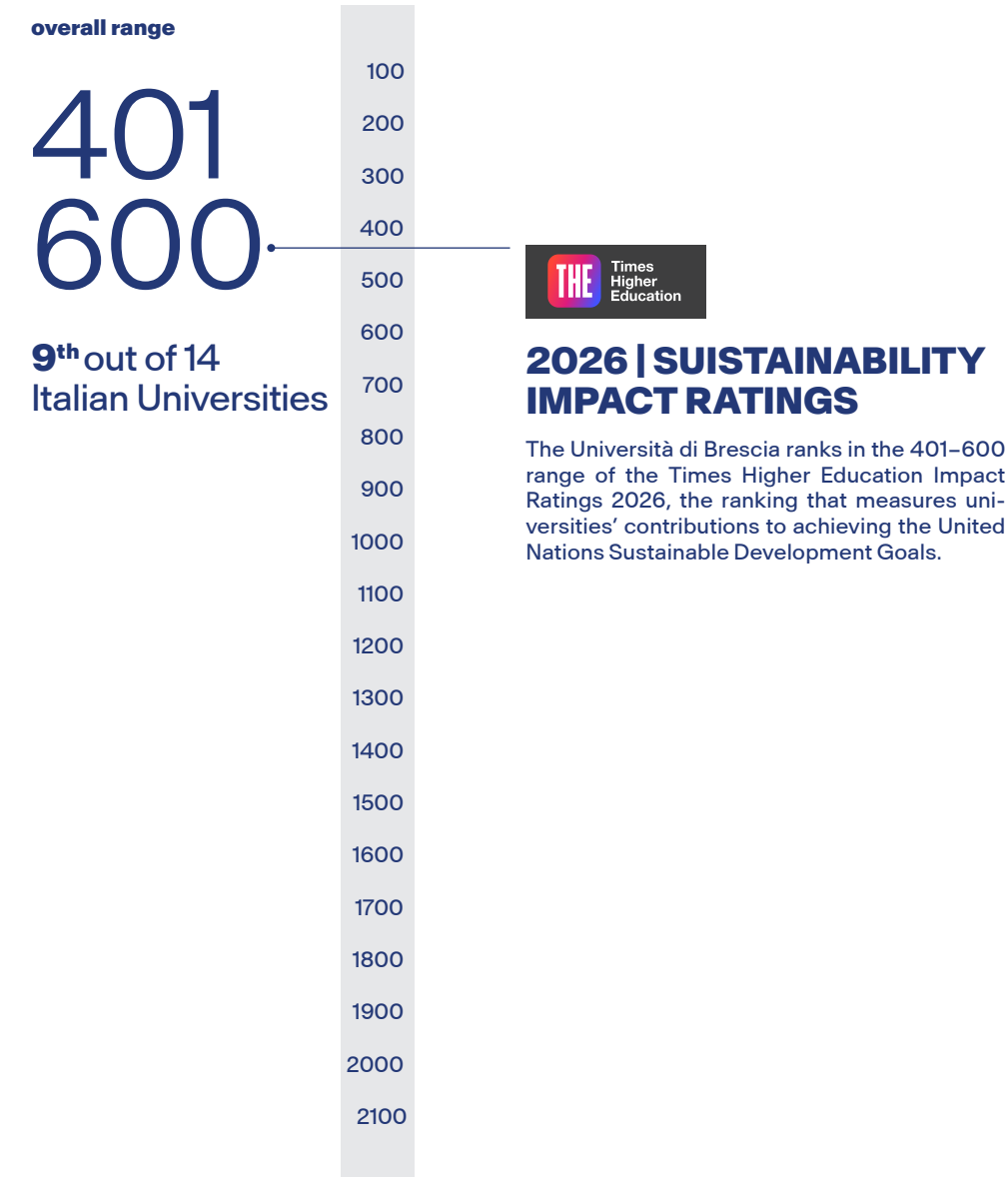

(out of 2,191 ranked institutions from 115 countries)

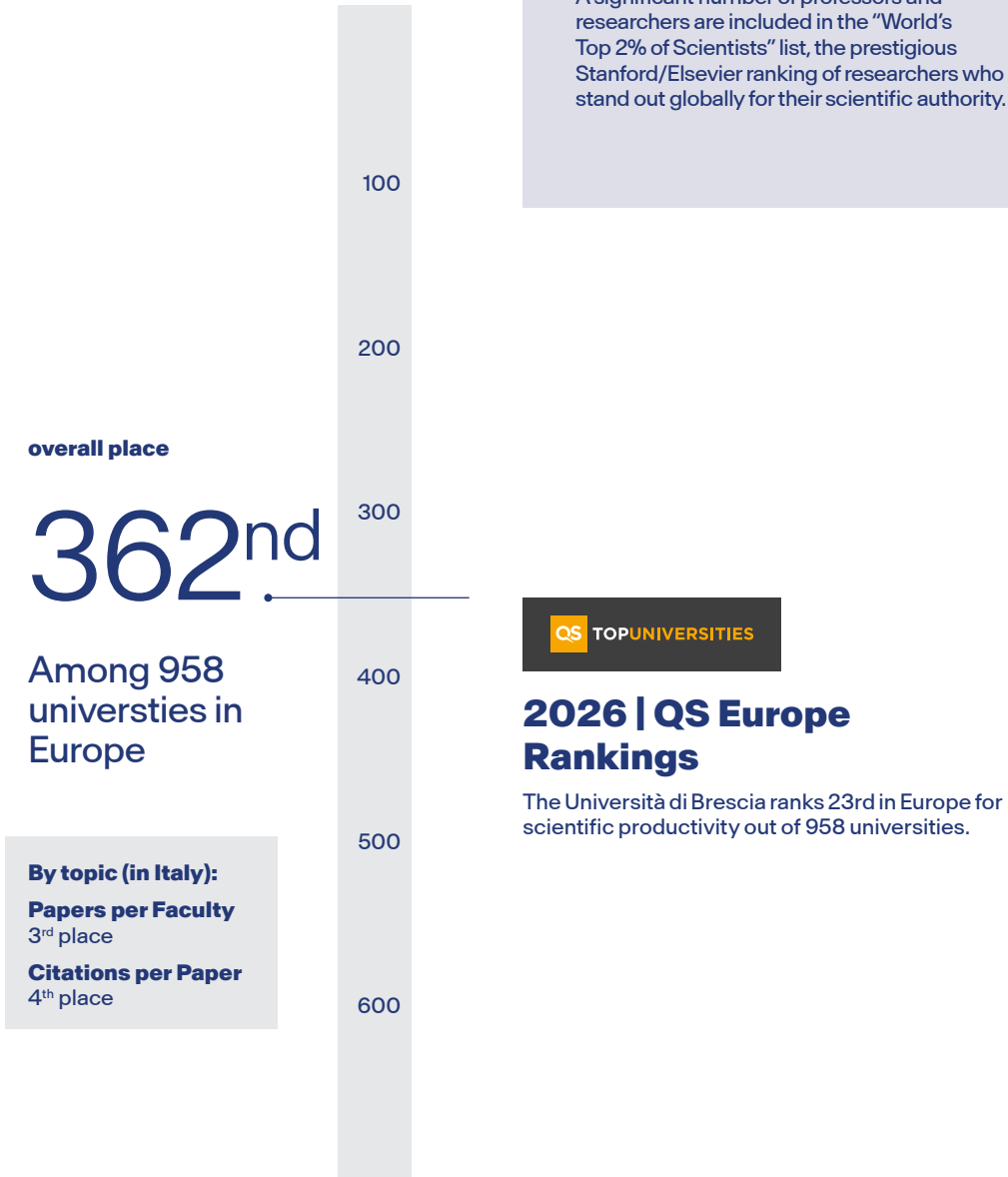

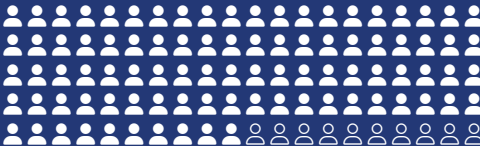

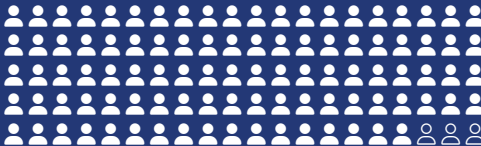
