This Master of Science Degree, taught in English, is offered at the Department of Civil, Environmental, Architectural Engineering and Mathematics at the University of Brescia, Italy. To be eligible, students should have a 3-year Bachelor's Degree or equivalent in Civil Engineering or in Environmental Engineering, with a background in Calculus, Physics, Chemistry, Fluid mechanics and Structural mechanics. A B2-level of English is required. Student exchange programmes with foreign Universities are available.
