

NOTICE

National fund to support access to rented housing for non-resident university students during the year 2021

Art. 1 Object

The University of Brescia, as indicated by the Ministry of University and Research (henceforth MUR) in the interministerial MUR-MEF Decree prot. n. 1013 of 30.07.2021, Contribution for housing rental expenses incurred by non-resident students (Article 1, paragraphs 526 and 527 of the budget law of 30 December 2020, n.178), issues this notice for the collection of applications to contribute supporting the rental costs incurred by non-resident university students during the year 2021.

Art. 2 Recipients

As indicated by the MUR through the aforementioned Ministerial Decree, only non-resident students - residing in a different place than the one where the rented property is located - regularly enrolled in the academic year 2020/2021 to a Degree Course_at the University of Brescia, belonging to a family unit having a valid ISEE (Equivalent Financial Situation Indicator) income declaration for the Right to Higher Education) not exceeding € 20,000.00, who do not benefit from other public contributions for accommodation (by this also meaning subsidies in the form of a housing service and not only in the form of an economic contribution) can be recipients of the financial aid grant.

Art. 3 Admission requirements

Students who submit the request to receive the rent payment for the current year must meet the following requirements:

- be regularly enrolled in a degree course at the University of Brescia for the 2020/2021 academic year;
- be a non-resident student,, residing in a different place than the one where the rented property is located;
- have a valid ISEE income declaration for the Right to Higher Education for 2021 not exceeding € 20,000.00; pursuant to art. 9 of DPCM 159/2013 it is also possible to submit the current ISEE declaration when- despite already having a valid ISEE- a change in the work situation or an interruption of social security, welfare and indemnity treatments not included in the total income (declared for IRPEF purposes) for one or more members of the family unit takes place; or when a decrease in the overall income capacity of the family unit is greater than 25%.



Art. 4 Submission of applications

Applications must be submitted by 12pm on 30/10/2021 via app by clicking on the following link: https://pica.cineca.it/unibs/dsu2021-bsee013 and must, under penalty of exclusion:

- be thoroughly filled;
- be signed by the applicant;
- be accompanied by a valid identification document as well as all the required documentation.

If applications do not comply with the indicated requirements or are incomplete or submitted after the set deadline and / or in a different way from the one indicated above, they will not be accepted. Under penalty of exclusion, applications must be submitted with the following documentation (in pdf format):

- 1. copy of a valid identity card;
- 2. self-certification of residence pursuant to Presidential Decree no. 445/2000, in the awareness of the criminal sanctions provided for by art. 76 of the same Presidential Decree in case of false and misleading declarations;
- 3. valid ISEE income declaration for the Right to Higher Education issued in 2021;
- 4. copy of the lease agreement with the registration and the receipts of rent payments for 2021.

Art. 5 Benefit Payment modality for applicants

Following preliminary investigation and controls undertaken on the submitted applications the University will send the data of the students entitled to the contribution and the estimated amount of the financial need to the Ministry of University and Research.

A national maximum amount of 15 million euros and the *pro capite* amount of contribution for eligible students have been established by the Ministry of the University and Research according to the maximum total expense and to the number of eligible students that will be communicated to the Ministry by all state universities

Based on the amount of the economic support issued by the MUR, the Atheneum will provide the contribution to eligible students.

Art. 6 Processing of personal data

The processing of personal data provided by candidates takes place in compliance with the EU Regulation - cd. GDPR (General Data Protection Regulation), as well as through the use of computerized procedures, for the institutional purposes of the Data Holder and for the undertaking of the activities related to this call for application. The Data Holder is the University of Brescia, in the person of the Rector, who has appointed the Frareg Srl company as a responsible authority, in the person of Dr. Stefano Guido.
