CHINA'S PRESENT AND FUTURE ECONOMIC GROWTH

In una prospettiva di Economia strutturale dello sviluppo il seminario coordinato da ALBERTO QUADRIO CURZIO si basa sulla Lectio del **PROFESSOR FU JUN** dell'università di Pechino che presenta un modello analitico ed empirico per valutare lo sviluppo della Cina nel lungo periodo. Il prof FU JUN ha recentemente pubblicato il volume *Climate Mitigation and Adaptation in China. Policy, Technology and Market* (Springer, 2021) al quale il prof Alberto Quadrio Curzio ha scritto l'endorsement riportato in fondo.

Ne discutono il prof PATRIZIO BIANCHI, il prof GIORGIO PRODI e il prof GIOVANNI ANDORNINO da vari punti di vista (teorico, empirico, istituzionale, geoeconomico) segue dibattito.

The seminar from a Structural Economics of Development perspective is coordinated by ALBERTO QUADRIO CURZIO and is based on the keynote address by **PROFESSOR FU JUN** from Peking University, who will present an analytical and empirical model for assessing China's long-term development.

Professor FU JUN recently published *Climate Mitigation and Adaptation in China. Policy, Technology and Market* (Springer, 2021) to which Professor ALBERTO QUADRIO CURZIO wrote the endorsement below.
