The workshop will focus on innovative methodological tools in the field of the energy transition. Researchers will present new modelling approaches and applications, while also engaging in discussions about further extensions in this area of study. The event will be structured into two distinct sessions. On day 1, we will have a session dedicated to micro modelling, uncertainty and applications, Day 2 will feature a session on macro modelling and applications. Each session will consist of presentations of research papers, including those at an early stage,



along with dedicated time for research debate. Additionally, there will be a special session for PhD students to present their work.
