## **Scholarship reserved for students with international protection a.y. 2024/2025**

### ***Art. 1 Purpose***

The University of Brescia, for the Academic Year 2024/2025, hereby issues this Call for the awarding of n.13 scholarships reserved for students with international protection in Italy, even temporary, obtain in case of military conflicts, social unrest, natural disasters, epidemic.

The scholarships shall be distributed among applicants as follows:

- 3 scholarships for students enrolled in the a.y. 2024/2025 in the Foundation Year, for an amount of € 6.000, of which €4.800 will be used to cover the registration cost of the Foundation Year.
- 5 scholarships for an amount of € 4.800 gross per year, for students enrolled in the a.y. 2023/2024 in a Single and Second cycle degree course, who renew their enrollment for the a.y. 2024/2025 and have acquired, in the period 11<sup>th</sup> August 2023 – 10<sup>th</sup> August 2024, at least 24 CFUs. Credits obtained in previous careers will not be counted.
- 5 scholarships for an amount of € 4.800 gross per year, for students enrolled for the a.y. 2024/2025, in a Single and Second cycle degree course, giving priority to applicants who in the a.y. 2023/2024 have obtained the final certification of the Foundation Year, from Università degli Studi di Brescia, after passing all the exams of the entire course.

### ***Art. 2 Requirements***

1. Be in possession of international protection in Italy, even if temporary;
2. Specific requirements:
  - For students enrolled, for the a.y. 2023/2024, in a Single or Second cycle degree course, who renew their enrollment for the a.y. 2024/2025: have obtained, from 11<sup>th</sup> August 2023 to 10<sup>th</sup> August 2024, at least 24 CFUs.

- For students enrolled, for the a.y. 2023/2024 in the Foundation Year, who enroll in the first year of a Bachelor's Degree or a Single cycle Master's degree in the a.y. 2024/2025: have obtained the final certificate after passing all the exams of the entire course.
- For students enrolled in a Bachelor's degree or Master's degree: have a valid qualification and the requirements for the selected course.
- For student enrolled in the Foundation Year: have a foreign qualification, finalization of the enrolment procedure and having attended at least 70% of the lessons of the first and second semester.

### ***Art. 3*** ***Application submission***

Applicants wishing to apply for the scholarship must apply by 13.00 Italian time of 23<sup>rd</sup> October 2024, via the PICA procedure available from the following link:

Once filled out the form must be printed, signed, scanned and upload.

Applications will not be accepted if they do not comply with the requirements set out, are incomplete and/or are not sent with the required documentation or received after the deadline set and/or are submitted in a manner different from that indicated above.

Documents to be attached to the online application are the following:

1. a valid identity document, preferably a passport;
2. residence permit and any documentation useful to prove the status of international protection.

All candidates must have all the required documents to access the desired course.

The board reserves the right to require additional documents regarding the status of international protection.

### ***Art. 4*** **Preparation of the ranking list**

The merit ranking will be drawn up by a special Board, appointed by Chancellor's Decree, composed of at least 5 members.

Scholarship shall be awarded based on the following criteria:

- **Students enrolled for the a.y. 2023/2024 in single and second cycle course (renewal):**

Number of CFUs obtained from 11<sup>th</sup> August 2023 to 10<sup>th</sup> August 2024. In the event of several applicants with the same number of CFUs, priority will be given to the candidate with the highest weighted average mark;

- **Students enrolling in the a.y. 2024/2025 in a single and second cycle course:**

High school diploma mark or, if not available, the average mark of the exams of the last year of course. Priority will be given to applicants who in the a.y. 2023/2024 have obtained the final certification of the Foundation Year, from Università degli Studi di Brescia, after passing all the exams of the entire course.

In the event of several applicants with the same scoring, priority shall be given to the younger one.

- **Students enrolling in the a.y. 2024/2025 in the Foundational Year:**

High school Diploma mark or, if not available, the average mark of the exams of the last year of course.

In the event of several applicants with the same scoring, priority shall be given to the younger one.

Any scholarships not allocated due to the depletion of winning positions in one of the ranking lists, shall be redistributed, without any change to the amount, based on criteria to be defined by the board.

The ranking will be published on the University website [www.unibs.it](http://www.unibs.it) within the 29<sup>th</sup> November 2024.

The total number of scholarships may be increased in the event additional funding becoming available

#### ***Art. 5***

##### ***Payment of scholarships***

Scholarships will be paid on a monthly basis within 30 days from the notification to the U.O.C. Diritto allo studio of bank account information on which the scholarship must be paid, after the enrolling process is completed.

Students enrolled in the Foundation Year will received the amount of 1.200 euros in two installments after the first and the second semester if they have attended at least 70% of the lessons. Payment will not be perform if students fail to reach the requested attendance.

#### ***Art. 6***

##### ***Taxation***

For scholarships awarded to students with foreign citizenship, the exemption laid down in art.3, paragraph 3, letter d-ter of the TUIR (Income Tax Consolidation Act) applies.

#### ***Art. 7***

##### ***Enrolment***

In order to enrol into the chosen course the successful candidates must verify the entry requirements with the Segreteria Studenti or Ufficio Ammissione Studenti Internazionali.

#### ***Art. 8***

##### ***Fees, accommodation and restaurant services***

Scholarship recipients are exempted from the payment of university fees except for the regional fee and the stamp duty (156.00 €).

Scholarship recipient students who enrol in the Foundation Year are exempted from the payment of the admission fees, since it is covered by the scholarship.

To check any accommodation availability, it is necessary to open a ticket to the U.O.C. Diritto allo studio through the service INFOSTUDENTE. Scholarship holders will be charged the lowest fare.

Catering service, if requested, is charged at the first bracket price for services for the right to education. Accommodation and catering service can be requested only by students enrolled in a Bachelor's degree, Master's degree or Single cycle master's degree.

#### ***Art. 09***

##### ***Incompatibility***

The scholarship cannot be awarded to students who receive/are receiving other grants from Italian public bodies for the same academic year.

#### ***Art. 10***

##### **Protection of Personal Data**

The processing of personal data provided by candidates for the aforementioned purposes is carried out in compliance with the EU Regulation - GDPR (General Data Protection Regulation). The Data Controller is the University of Brescia, in the person of the Magnificent Chancellor, who has appointed as Data Protection Officer (DPO) Liguria Digitale S.p.A., in the person of dell'Ing. The processing of the personal data provided by the candidates when participating in the selection of this Call for Applications is aimed solely at carrying out selection activities and will be carried out by the personnel in charge of the procedure, including through the use of computerised procedures, in the ways and within the limits necessary to pursue the aforementioned purposes, even in the event of disclosure to third parties. The processing will also be carried out by Cineca - Consorzio interuniversitario. This data must be provided for evaluation

of the participation requirements, under penalty of exclusion from the selection procedure. The data transmitted by the data subject will be processed by means of appropriate guarantees and security measures - manual and/or electronic, in order to ensure their protection and confidentiality.
