ORAL PART (approx. 10 minutes on a later date)

Task 1: Introductory questions e.g.: *What do you do in your spare time? Where did you go on holiday last summer? What are your future plans?*

Task 2: Topic-related questions: the examiner will present you with a topic to talk about, and will ask you to give reasons to support your arguments. Example topics include: education, technology, work, etc.
