

4) WRITING (Total 10 points)

ORAL PART (approx. 10 minutes on a later date)

Task 1: Simple questions about yourself to find out where you are from, your age, what you like to do in your spare time.

Task 2: Short monologue. You will be shown a picture, and you will be asked to describe it. The themes of the pictures cover the topics of the syllabus

Task 3: Interaction. Engage in a role-play with your language instructor. E.g.: You are in a coffee shop and the person sitting next to you introduces themself and starts talking. Engage in the conversation and end the interaction with an appointment to go to the movie theater.
