

Call for Incoming Teaching Mobilities – PNRR TNE LEGO Project

CALL FOR APPLICATIONS

TNE LEGO PROJECT (TNE-0050 CUP D81I24000280007) Incoming Faculty Mobility – Academic Year 2024/2025

This is an unofficial translation. The text in Italian is the official text approved by the Rector.

ART. 1 – THE TNE LEGO PROJECT

The TNE LEGO project ("Italy–East Asia Cooperation: from Local Expertise to a Global Outlook") is a transnational education initiative funded by the European Union's **NextGenerationEU** program under **Mission 4, Component 2** of Italy's **National Recovery and Resilience Plan (PNRR)**.

The project runs from **1 September 2024 to 31 March 2026** and aims to strengthen cooperation between **12 Italian universities** and **partner institutions in East Asia** (China, Korea, Japan, and Southeast Asia), promoting **educational innovation**, **intercultural exchange**, and **internationalization** of Italian higher education.

ART. 2 – OBJECT OF THE CALL

With this call, the **University of Brescia (UNIBS)** will select:

- **21 professors** for **short-term mobility** (6 days)
- **2 positions** for **long-term mobility** (2 months)

The project will cover travel, accommodation, and subsistence costs as follows:

- Round-trip airfare: up to **EUR 1,000** for all countries, **EUR 1,500** from Japan
- Subsistence and accommodation:
 - Up to **EUR 700.00** per person for **short-term stays (6 days)**
 - Up to **EUR 3,500.00/month** for **long-term stays (2 months)**

Upon request, the University of Brescia may directly purchase flight tickets and accommodation.

Mobilities must be completed by **28 February 2026**.

ART. 3 – ELIGIBILITY

Eligible applicants are teaching staff **under contract** at one of the following **partner universities**:

 - Environmental Science and Technologies
- **Hanoi University of Science and Technology (HUST)**

Note: For universities with a Memorandum of Understanding (MoU) pending signature, mobilities can only take place after the agreement has been signed.

Teaching proposals must **fall within the disciplinary areas** defined in the **bilateral agreements** between the sending institution and UNIBS.

ART. 4 – SELECTION CRITERIA

Applications will be evaluated by a **committee composed of:**

- Prof. **Corrado Paganelli**, Scientific Coordinator of the TNE LEGO project at UNIBS
- Prof. **Roberto Ranzi**, Vice Rector for International Relations
- Ms. **Aiko Terao**, Head of the International Relations Office

Alternate members:

- Dr. **Anjeza Metushi**, International Mobility Officer – UNIBS
- Prof. **Carmen Marchiori**, Rector's Delegate for International Promotion
- Prof. **Silvia Giliani**, Rector's Delegate for International Research

Evaluation criteria:

1. **Academic and professional excellence**, as demonstrated in the CV (max **10 points**)
2. **Quality and relevance of the teaching proposal**, in line with the bilateral agreement and the project's strategic objectives (max **10 points**)

Applications scoring **less than 12 points** will be excluded.

The **results will be published within 30 days** of the deadline on the UNIBS website.

ART. 5 – APPLICATION PROCEDURE

Applications must be submitted **via online form**, including the **CV** and the following documents:

- **For short visits (5 days + travel):**
A teaching/seminar proposal with **title, brief abstract, and proposed period** (to be confirmed after selection)
- **For long visits (2 months):**
A **detailed program** for teaching and research
- **Proof of appointment** at the home institution

ART. 6 – PROCEDURE OFFICER

According to Law no. 241 of 7 August 1990, the officer in charge is **Ms. Aiko Terao**, Head of the U.O.C.C. International Relations Office, University of Brescia.

All documentation will be stored at the **International Mobility Office**.

ART. 7 – DATA PROTECTION


The personal data provided by applicants will be processed in compliance with **EU Regulation 2016/679 (GDPR)**.

The University of Brescia is the **data controller** (art. 26 GDPR), and will implement adequate technical and organizational measures to ensure data protection.

Data processing is mandatory for participating in the selection. Where sensitive data are involved, processing follows **Law 68/1999** and **Law 104/1992**.

The **CINECA consortium** has been appointed **data processor** under art. 28 GDPR. It will ensure full compliance and will not share data with third parties.

Data will be retained **only for as long as necessary** (“storage limitation principle”, art. 5 GDPR) and reviewed periodically.

For all matters not expressly covered in this call, **current legislation and university regulations** on public competitions and scholarships will apply.
