## **EBSCO** eBook Academic Collection

The titles included in the **EBSCO eBook Academic Collection** can be searched by clicking on the **e-book and e-journal Publication Finder** link or by connecting to the EBSCO platform.

Consultation, restricted to **institutional users** only, can take place within the **university network** or from **outside** by authenticating through the usual ways (see the page **off-campus access information**).

There are two possible modalities to use e-books:

- **Read online**: the text, in PDF or ePub format, can be consulted directly on the platform. The user can print to PDF, send by e-mail or save to PDF a predetermined number of pages (usually 40 or 100), the count of which is shown and constantly updated. The copy and paste function is generally allowed, except in certain cases.
- **Download**: The e-book can be downloaded in **digital lending** mode. The users have to log in or create a My Ebsco account. Then, they can choose the duration of the loan (1 to 4 weeks) and the file format (PDF or ePub). Users are required to install Adobe Digital Editions for desktop reading or a dedicated app for mobile devices (while using the EBSCO Mobile app, neither an Adobe ID nor Adobe Digital Editions installation is needed). Firstly, an ACSM file is downloaded, opening which the download of the book starts. The text, protected by DRM, remains available for the set period, after which it becomes inaccessible. Printing and copying and pasting are prohibited.

There are no limits on simultaneous users or permitted downloads of titles.
