## **Ebook Central**

All titles in the Ebook Central catalogue are searchable by clicking on the **Find e-books and e-journals** link or by using the ProQuest platform.

Consultation of the resource is reserved exclusively for **institutional users**. Access always requires authentication via **EZproxy**, (both inside the **university network** and **outside**). For authentication via EZproxy, see the instructions on the page **Information for off-campus access**.

For **titles already purchased** from the University Library System:

- Online reading: the text can be consulted on the platform without time limit. Printing (in PDF) and copy-pasting are permitted within the limits indicated by the system and updated from time to time.
- **Downloading**: the user can download the e-book via the **digital lending** service. You choose the type of device, the file format (PDF or ePub) and, if required, the duration of the loan (1 to 14 days); Adobe Digital Editions or another compatible app must be installed. An ACSM file is downloaded, opening which the download of the book is completed. The e-book, protected by DRM, remains available for the set period, at the end of which it becomes inaccessible. Even for the downloaded version, printing and copy-pasting are permitted within the limits indicated by the system.

For **titles not purchased** from the University Library System:

- Online reading: the entire text can be consulted for a limited time (up to 5 minutes), after which reading cannot be continued. Printing and copy and paste are blocked.
- **Downloading**: the user submits a **request** for access to the title by filling in the appropriate box (first and last name, e-mail, department, desired duration of loan 1 to 14 days). The request is processed by the staff within 3 days. If the request is accepted, the applicant receives an e-mail with the link to access the e-book and download it as a **digital loan**. The duration of the loan may be different from that requested by the user.

## N.B.

- In case of numerous digital loan requests for the same e-book, its purchase will be evaluated. Users are therefore invited to indicate in the request box whether the title is used as a textbook for provided teaching at the university.
- Purchase and digital lending on the platform are financed with a predefined budget, so they are possible until the budget ends.

For some titles, there are limits on the number of simultaneous users. The temporary unavailability of the title is indicated on the e-book presentation page.
