MLOL: MediaLibraryOnLine

Access to MLOL is restricted to **institutional users**, who must authenticate using their **university credentials** via the dedicated **portal** created for the University of Brescia. The resource is accessible both **on-campus** and **off-campus**.

MLOL e-books are **not** searchable through the **Publication Finder (e-books and e-journals)**.

In addition to free resources, users have access to all titles included in the **Digital Interlibrary Loan** network: around 70,000 e-books purchased by participating libraries and shared among all institutions.

E-books cannot be read online and must be **downloaded** through the **digital loan** service (up to **4 downloads per month**, each one lasting for **14 days**). If a title is currently occupied, users can place a reservation and they will receive an email notification when it becomes available.

E-books are available in PDF and/or EPUB format, protected by DRM. Most of them are now compatible with **Readium LCP** DRM protection; to read them, users have to install the new MLOL Ebook Reader app (available for Windows, MacOS, Linux Ubuntu; iOS, Android). This app does not require an Adobe ID.

For devices not supporting Readium LCP or for e-books still protected by traditional Adobe DRM, users must install **Adobe Digital Editions** (and create an Adobe ID) or the **previous MLOL Reader app**, if still installed.

A dual-mode navigation system allows users to choose between the new and old mode, depending on device compatibility.

If the downloaded file requests an **App Code** or **Passphrase**, these can be found under "**I MIEI DATI (My Data)**" in the user's MediaLibrary account.
