## McGraw-Hill eBooks Collections

The 60 McGraw-Hill titles subscribed to by our university, not included in the *Access Engineering* and *Access Medicine* collections, can be searched by clicking on the *Publication Finder (e-books and e-journals)* link or by going to the **VitalSource Bookshelf** platform (for the titles, please see the attached list).

This resource, for **institutional users** only, is available both on-campus and off-campus (via the standard authentication) (see the *Off-campus access information* webpage).

## E-book access options:

- **online reading**, without digital loan: no registration required; click on *Borrow* to read.
- **online consultation** with **digital loan**: registration and login required; by clicking on *Borrow*, the user can check out the e-book for **5 days** (early return possible by clicking on *Return*);
- **download** with **digital loan:** after borrowing the e-book (**DRM** protected) the user can download it using the **VitalSource Bookshelf app** for PCs and mobile devices.

When accessing via the *Publication Finder (e-books and e-journals)* link, the e-book opens directly, without clicking on *Borrow*.

The text is in **ePub** format. **Printing** is allowed within the system limits, and **copy and paste** functions are available. Each title is accessible by **5 simultaneous users**. There is no limit on the number of e-books that a single user can simultaneously borrow.

Some titles include additional content via the **Connect** platform (e.g. exercise books, etc.). Students can email **servizio.clienti@mheducation.com** indicating the volume of interest to request information on Connect availability and how to access it.
