



**Entry requirements for English taught Corsi di laurea magistrale (master's degrees)
to be met by holders of foreign qualifications**

Master's degree in Analytics and data science for economics and management

To be considered for admission we require:

1. undergraduate degree of at least three years;
2. minimum overall grade of 77/100 in the undergraduate degree (corresponding to an Italian grade of 85/110);
3. have acquired at least 30 academic credits (with a tolerance of 6) during the previous academic career in the following fields and disciplines: IT, Engineering, Mathematics, Econometrics, Statistics, Physics, Medical statistics, Psychometrics;
4. English proficiency at minimum level of B2 CEFR in a recognized English language test; or attendance of an English taught undergraduate degree; or have passed during the previous academic career English language exams (at least 3 ECTS); or have achieved at least 60 academic credits in English taught courses during the previous academic career.

Furthermore, the appointed commission assesses candidates' personal preparation during an interview in English, aimed at verifying the individual knowledge and skills in three main fields: Computer science, Mathematics and Statistics. Only those candidates that sit and pass the oral test are considered eligible for admission.

The interview has been scheduled on 10 April 2026.

Master's degree in Civil and environmental engineering

To be considered for admission we require:

1. undergraduate degree of at least three years in a discipline consistent with the Laurea Magistrale for which the candidate is applying, including one subject of structural mechanics (or similar) and one subject of hydraulics, both corresponding to 5 ECTS;
2. minimum overall grade of 77/100 in the undergraduate degree (corresponding to an Italian grade of 85/110);
3. English proficiency at minimum level of B2 CEFR in a recognized English language test or attendance of an English taught undergraduate degree.

Master's degree in Management (curriculum International business or curriculum Green economy and sustainability)

To be considered for admission we require:

1. undergraduate degree of at least three years that, based upon the transcript of the exams taken, shows the candidate has acquired the minimum background in the following four basic areas of knowledge: Accounting and management, Economics, Mathematics and statistics, and Law;
2. minimum overall grade of 77/100 in the undergraduate degree (corresponding to an Italian grade of 85/110);
3. English proficiency at minimum level of B2 CEFR in a recognized English language test or attendance of an English taught undergraduate degree or have passed during the previous academic career English language exams (at least 3 ECTS).
