



## Step-by-step procedure for admission to English taught Laurea (undergraduate program) in Business and Economics

### 1. Qualifications required for admission

To get admission to the study program candidates must have achieved

- Final Upper secondary school diploma, obtained after at least 12 years of schooling and that allows access to higher education in the foreign education system
- English-language certificate at least at level B2, [among those accepted by Economics Department](#)

*or alternatively*

- a Medium of Instruction (MOI) declaration if classes were entirely delivered in English during the upper secondary-school.

Non-EU citizens that apply for visa should attach the above listed documents in [Universitaly portal](#): in the absence of this documentation, the application cannot be approved by our office.

### 2. Prepare foreign qualification documents you must submit to complete enrollment process

Prepare legalization by foreign authorities and Declaration of value issued by Italian Representation:

- [non-EU citizens living abroad that enter Italy with study visa](#)
- [EU and EU-equivalent citizens](#)

Alternatively, ask online via DIPLOME portal [CIMEA](#) for Statement of comparability and Statement of verification.

### 3. Take the CEnT-S (CISIA English Test – Sciences)

The [CEnT-S](#) indicative online test is mandatory for admission, but it does not prevent you to enroll in case of a score lower than required. The test can be sat from January until mid-October 2026 and is fully managed by CISIA board. A registration fee of 55 euros should be paid.

You are required to complete only the Mathematics section: the test is passed if you obtain a normalized score of at least 11 points. Please, be informed that the score that appears on the screen at the end of the test is not the actual one: you must wait till the end of the macro-period in which you take the test to find the final score in your personal area in CISIA portal.

Applicants who do not take the test before enrollment, or who obtain a normalized score below 11 points, may still enroll, but will be assigned [Additional Learning Requirements \(ALRs\) in Mathematics](#).

### 4. Online enrollment

Starting from July 2026 you are allowed to complete the [online enrollment procedure](#).

Non-EU citizens living abroad will be enabled to enroll only upon issuance of study visa.

### 5. Submission of documents concerning your foreign qualification

Once you have completed the online enrollment, you must submit the documents concerning your foreign upper-secondary school qualification to the [International Students Admission Desk](#) to have your enrolment approved.

Non-EU citizens living abroad must submit documents after their arrival in Italy.
