

Antonello Calore (Sulmona 1952), graduated *cum laude* in Law from the University of Macerata, is Full Professor of Roman Law at the Faculty of Law of the University of Brescia. He was Dean of the Faculty of Law of the University of Brescia from 2004 to 2010. He represents the University of Brescia in the scientific board of the Festival of Peace of Brescia (2017-2018).

He did research outside Italy, in particular in France (Paris) and in Germany. Between 1989 and 1995 he was a member of the interdisciplinary study group located at the Castle of Gargonza in Tuscany, whose researches were published in the series entitled *I Quaderni di Gargonza* (The Gargonza Papers).

From 2002 to 2010, he took part to the teaching Staff of the Ph.D. “*Roman Law and European Legal Science*” of the University of Pavia. He was editor of national research projects. Moreover he was Coordinator of the unit of the University of Brescia in the Projects PRIN 2003, 2005, 2007. He coordinated the Italian-Argentinian research Project CUIA (2011-2012). He is member of the steering committee of the *Bullettino dell’Istituto di diritto romano*.
