Alberto Ferlin, born in 1969, received his MD at the University of Padova (Italy) in 1995, specialization in Endocrinology and Metabolism in 2000 and PhD in Endocrinological and Haematological Sciences in 2005 at the same University. He is Associate Professor of Endocrinology at the University of Padova from 2018 and previously Associate Professor of Clinical Pathology at the University of Padova. He is President of the Italian Society of Andrology and Sexual Medicine (SIAMS) for the two-year period 2016-2018. Principal research fields include molecular biology and genetics of male infertility, cryptorchidism and testicular cancer; role of FSH in the regulation of spermatogenesis and pharmacogenetics of male infertility; molecular and clinical aspects of Klinefelter syndrome; testis-bone cross-talk and in general the endocrinology of testis. Invited speaker and member of POC of many international congresses and organizers of tens of national congresses. Author of almost 200 publications on international journal and author of various books and book chapter in the field of andrology and male reproduction. Impact factor (IF) is >1000, citations are >5500, H-index is 50.
